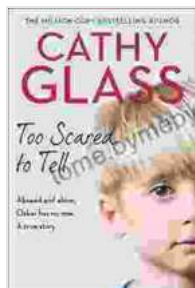

She hopes that Oskar's story will inspire others to overcome their own challenges and to never give up hope.

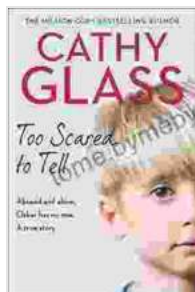

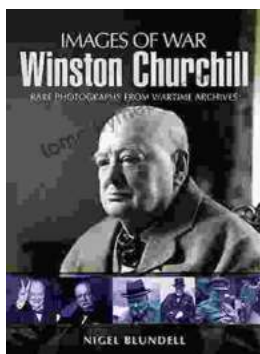
