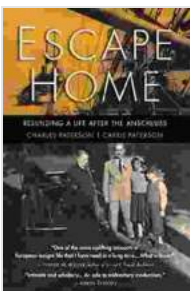


Escape Home: Rebuilding Life After the Anschluss

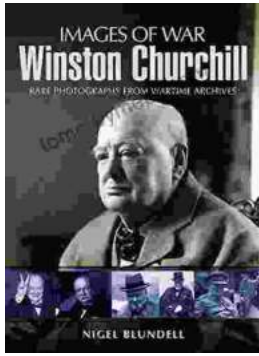
