




Humble Beginnings



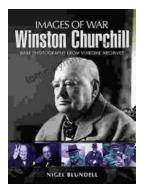
